Class Reading: John 3:1-21

(Most of the questions in lessons 1, 2, 6, and 8 may be answered for the greatest part from St. John the 4th book of the New Testament. The questions and answers helps us to know how to be saved and what it means to be “born again”.)

1. Who was it in John 3:16 that loved the world? _____
2. Whom did God give for everyone in the world in John 3:16?

3. Who do you believe is the one sent to save the world in John 3:17?

Ref: John 1:1-17

4. Did God send His Son, the Lord Jesus Christ into the world to condemn the world? according to John 3:17? _____
5. Why did God send His Son into the world according to John 3:17?

6. Where does the Bible teach us that one is condemned or not saved based on what he does not believed?
Is it John 1:1 - Yes or No
Or John 3:18 – Yes or No
7. So salvation, (saved eternally from our sins, to live with God) is as simple as believing basic facts about God’s son, the SAVIOR according to John 3:18? Yes or No
8. Why would a man reject the light or RIGHT or God’s son according to John 3:19?

Class Reading: John 8:1-59

9. Let’s be crystal clear! Who is the light of the world according to John 8:12? _____
10. Let’s be crystal clear again! How then does a person become, as the Holy Bible says, “Born Again” according to John 1:1-12&13?

Class Reading: John 6:1-40

John 1:12&13 are key verses in one knowing that he is really saved, for they confirm that it is when one receives the Lord Jesus into his heart, he at that moment becomes “Born Again.”
