Lesson 6 Obedience

Obedience by Definition: "we are WILLING (eager, keen, enthusiastic, ready, prepared, and agreeable) to obey God and we will do EVERYTHING in our power to obey Him"

1. How is it that one can know <u>what exactly God is expecting of Him</u> according to the teachings of Jesus in St John 8:31? Then said Jesus to those Jews which believed on him, <mark>If ye continue</mark> in my word, then are ye my disciples indeed; and ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free.

2. How am I to know who's right and whose wrong when people present different meanings as to what the Bible is saying to me according to?

a. John 7:14-18 If any man will do his will, he shall know of the doctrine, whether it be of God, or whether I speak of myself. He that speaketh of himself seeketh his own glory: but he that seeketh his glory that sent him, the same is true, and no unrighteousness is in him. Be careful of the anything that sounds self seeking

b. 1 Corinthians 2:6-13-16 Every word we speak was taught to us by God's Spirit, not by human wisdom. And this same Spirit helps us teach spiritual things to spiritual people.^{[b] 14} That's why only someone who has God's Spirit can understand spiritual blessings. Anyone who doesn't have God's Spirit thinks these blessings are foolish. ¹⁵ People who are guided by the Spirit can make all kinds of judgments, but they cannot be judged by others. ¹⁶ The Scriptures ask, "Has anyone ever knownthe thoughts of the Lord or given him advice?" But we understand what Christ is thinking.^[C]

a. What will knowing and obeying the truth, do for us according to verse 32? **"Make us free" NIV "Set you free" Set means to put us in a position of freedom.**

b. Who is The Truth according to St. John 14:1-6? Jesus Christ

c. Ultimately The Truth is who according to St. John 10:22-30? God, for the Father and the Son are One.

4. Therefore according to St. John 14:15-21b, Obedience is summed up how? Whoever has my commands and keeps them is the one who loves me.

a. Is there a promise to us for being obedient in verse 21? Yes

b. If so, what is it? The one who loves me will be loved by my Father and I too will love them and show myself to them."

5. Should I ask myself continually as to whether or not I LOVE the LORD? Because I don't ever want my flesh to overpower my spirit, I should.

6. If I love Him, according to St. John 15:1-7 what two things should I do? Remain in Christ, and allow His Word to remain in me.

a. Is there a promise to me, according to St. John 15:7b for being obedient? Yes

7. According to St. John 14:23-27 who does every believer have to assist them in understanding and confirming God's will for our lives? The Advocate (Comforter and Supporter), or the Holy Spirit.

8. Why wouldn't someone hear and obey God according to St. John 8:47b? Whoever belongs to God hears what God says. The reason you do not hear is that you do not belong to God."

But you know him, for he lives with you and will be^[s] in you. ¹⁸ I will not leave you as orphans; I will come to you. ¹⁹ Before long, the world will not see me anymore, but you will see me. Because I live, you also will live. ²⁰ On that day you will realize that I

am in my Father, and you are in me, and I am in you.²¹ Whoever has my

commands and keeps them is the one who loves me. The one who loves me will be loved by my Father, and I too will love them and show myself to them."
